7. HOW TO REACH HOTEL AND THE SITE

13. LUNCHES ON SITE

Admission to the Opening Ceremony will be free of charge to Athletes, Team Officials, Technical Officials, Executive Board members, IWWF Cableski Council members, and Guests.

16. INTENTION TO ENTER

In accordance with IWWF Rule 2.05, each Federation is required to submit an Intention to Enter for the Championships.

Each Federation shall certify to the Chairman of the IWWF Cableski Council and to the organizing committee, not later than 60 days before the scheduled start of the familiarization of the 2024 IWWF Cableski World Championships, it's intent to compete. Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until they pay a fine of EUR 200 to the IWWF.

Submission deadline: 13th July 2024.

17. ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee is US\$280.00, per skier regardless of the number of disciplines. This amount includes a **US\$30.00** levy which will assist technical officials with their travel costs.

18. PAYMENT DETAILS (Entries, Trainings, Banquet)

Please, request for an invoice from the Organizer and ensure you correctly state the invoice number when making payment. Note, payments WITHOUT an invoice number may not be recognized by recipient. All transfers will need to be made to a bank account.

Remitting parties are responsible for ALL bank charges at both ends. Where bank charges have been deducted, Federations/Riders will be required to make good any shortfall at registration. Please present your Bank Transfer Voucher during registration on site to prove your payment.

19. IWWF LICENSE

Following an agreement by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF License fee from 2021 where athletes wishing to compete in Ranking List / 3 to 6 Star competitions (including IWWF World titled events) in each Sports Division of the IWWF are required to hold an IWWF License. It is requested that Federations ensure that all their athletes hold a valid IWWF License in order to participate in the 2024 IWWF World Cableski Championships.







20. REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS IN EMS

Each Federation shall register the athletes on the EMS not later than ten (10) days before the scheduled start of the first event of the competition, with the names of the members of its team and reserves and the events each will enter. The deadline for entry of athletes on EMS is 29th August 2024. Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of EUR 10 per skier per day after the 15-day deadline to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered. Late entries will only be accepted with the mutual consent of the Organiser and Chief Judge.

The registration of the rider participations in EMS has to be done by an EMS Federation Administrator as follows:

- 1. EMS Federation Administrator has to login to EMS
- 2. Go to the Competitions menu and set the Competition Code <24IWWF07> and the Country "Poland" in the Search Filters
- 3. Select the Code <24IWWF07> competition "2024 IWWF World Cableski Championships"
- 4. Scroll down to the Participations section and click the "New participation" button to register the Athletes
- 5. Enter the Name of the Athlete in the Search box and click on the loop sign to the right
- 6. Register the Category in Competition, the Event "and the Entry Type.
- 7. Click on the blue "+Add" button and the participant will be registered.

Repeat Steps 5 to 7 for any additional participants

Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of EUR 10 per skier per day after this deadline to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered. Late entries will only be accepted with the mutual consent of the Organizer and Chief Judge.

SIM cards

Poland offers several choices when it comes to buying a SIM card, with four main cell networks to choose from: Orange, Play, Plus, and T-Mobile.

There are many ways to buy SIM cards and packages: in supermarkets, street kiosks, gas (petrol) stations, and official company stores. It is mandatory to register with your passport or national ID card when buying a SIM card in Poland, due to an anti-terrorism act that went into effect around July 2016.

You can easily buy top-up vouchers in the same places you bought the SIM card, including street kiosks, stores, petrol stations, or online.

IMPORTANT: To be able to complete/populate their profiles, the Athletes must be EMS USERS, i.e. they must be invited by their respective Federations to become EMS users and have accepted this invitation.
